

LLEWELYN PHOTOGRAPHS

1. Photograph of Ll P signed by Doris Ullman. 15x20cm., matted 28.5x36. Photo in good condition but mat torn and in poor condition.
2. Photograph of Ll P 'given me by Alyse Gregory'. Also by Doris Ullman. Signed by Llewelyn Powys. 14.5x20.5, photo torn on left side; mat in poor condition.
3. Photograph of Ll P outside Chydyok with A.G.
4. Snapshot of Ll P in his shelter with Alyse Gregory and cat.
5. Framed photograph of Ll P in Swiss Alps with quotations from *Love and Death* and an inscription to Roy Worvill. Inscription faded.
6. Print of pen portrait of Ll P 1930. Signed Reginald Marsh.
7. Print of pen portrait of Ll P. Copy of above.
8. Original engraving by Reginald Marsh
9. Another of above.
10. Framed photograph of Llewelyn by Ullman, but slightly different pose from the two above.
11. Llewelyn entering court from car, with three other figures - probably Mrs Hardy, her chauffeur and Rivers Pollock, January, 1935. ***Given to Powys Collection, November, 1999 by M.K.
12. Snapshot of Llewelyn's stone with a letter from Alyse Gregory, 4th June, 1953, saying she would send some other photographs.
13. Photograph of Llewelyn in cape holding hat. On back: "Llewelyn Powys standing in front of his writing study made out of the last smuggler's boat to be taken by the coast guards off White Nose" (Photo glued to mat)
14. Negative of above.
15. Snapshot of Ll P in Switzerland with man, child, goat and hut. On back in Alyse's hand, "Llewelyn Powys in Switzerland, 1937.

16. Snapshot of bearded Llewelyn sitting on bench in Switzerland, hat on knees, and mountains behind.

17. Snapshot of Llew. Sitting on bench outside wooden hut.

18. Llewelyn standing, hat in hand, with bench and swiss mountain behind.

Note: 15, 16, 17, 18 in one sleeve.

19. Photograph of Llewelyn and brother Bertie. On back in Alyse's hand: "Llewelyn and A.R.P. about 1924. (Note enlargement in ARP file)

20. Duplicate of above, but nothing on back. [Possibly put in ARP file of photos.]

21. Llewelyn. On back in Alyse's hand: "Llewelyn Powys in Africa."

22. Llewelyn and Watson . On back: "Dr Sibley Watson and LI P in Rocky Mountains." [Note: Sibley Watson and Scofield Thayer were the owners of The Dial, of which Alyse Gregory was the managing director. He walked while Watson and trapper hunted bears. LI. Climbed (see Verdict of Bridlegoose) a mountain summit. Realized that his consumption, which had been quiescent for three years, was again active. The expedition occurred from end of May to late July, 1924.]

23. Llewelyn on horseback. On back: " Llewelyn Powys in the Rocky Mountains, 1924."

24. Llewelyn and brother Willie by washing line.

25. Snapshot of LI P in Switzerland in suit, bearded, wearing a cape. On back: "1938".

26. Snapshot of Llewelyn in Switzerland. On Back in Llew hand: "Katie with love from Lulu. A mountain garden at the beginning of the second Great War" with drawing of an ankh.

27. Snapshot identical to the framed photo of LIP sitting on seat in Swiss mountains. On back: "For Isabel from Lulu November 1938, but the picture was taken in 1937."

29. Snapshot of a house. On back: "Home of LI P Montana Catskill Mountains, N.Y."

30. Photo of LI P as child. On back in Alyse's hand: "LI P as child." (Several copies of this including one reproduced in Elwin's Life)

31. Photograph - professional of LI P at Cambridge University, Corpus (October, 1903 - November 1906) On back: Mess Stearne, Artists and Photographers, Cambridge.

32. Photograph of Llewelyn and Will as young men. No date. Photo by Bernard Griffin, Dorchester.

33. Photograph of Llewelyn, side faced. Matted. By W.H. Cummings, Weymouth. No date.

34. A smaller, unmatted duplicate of above.

35. Page torn out of book Elwin's *Life of Llewelyn*, (frontispiece) entitled 'Llewelyn Powys, 1934' Of Llewelyn lying in shelter.

36. Newspaper clipping dated May 22, 1938. photos of Llewelyn but no date.
