Bill Keith, Emeritus Professor of English at Toronto University, has written extensively on John Cowper Powys, and will be familiar to many members of the society from his talks at annual conferences. His readers’ guides to *Autobiography*, *A Glastonbury Romance*, *Porius*, and *Owen Glendower* can be downloaded from the Powys Society website. The Society has now published his monograph, “Aspects of John Cowper Powys’s *Owen Glendower*”, which explores the background and nature of this enthralling but often baffling and controversial novel. Bill Keith describes the historical background to the novel and its ties to ancient Welsh mythology, the gestation and publication of the book, its ties to the historical novels of Walter Scott and to Shakespeare, and its contemporary relevance. There is a guide to Welsh pronunciation supplied by David Klausner. Bill Keith’s monograph is available for immediate despatch.
