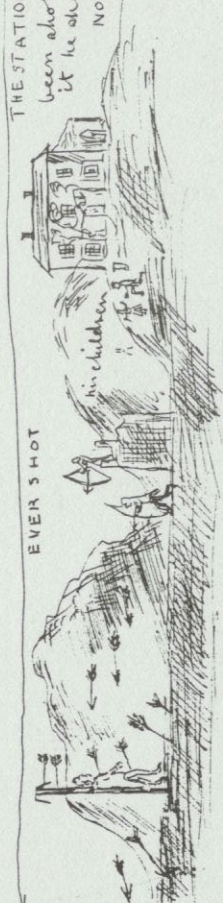

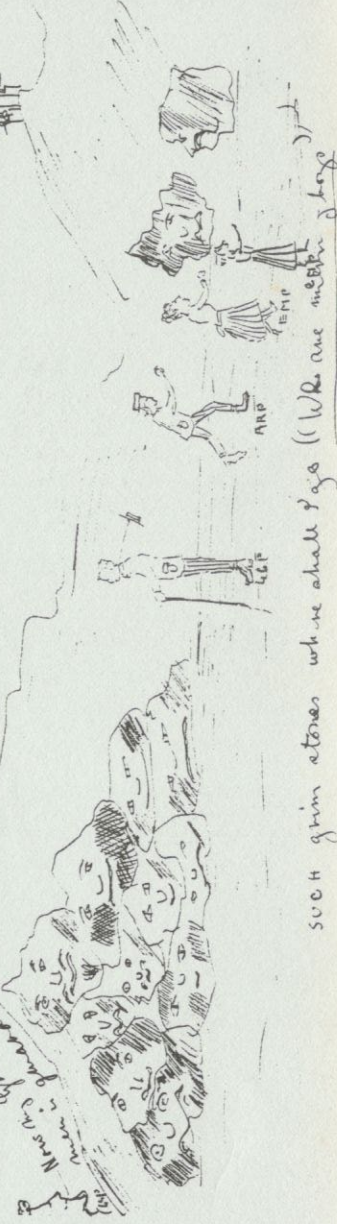


EVER SHOT
